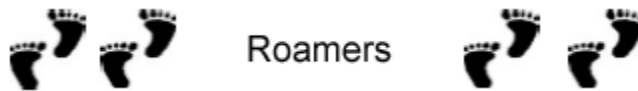



Chris Kimball returned to introduce our speaker, whom he first heard on the radio 12 years ago, Rabbi Daniel Lapin. Rabbi Lapin is a Mercer Island based author and the host of *Toward Tradition*, a national syndicated talk show, and a national coalition of Jews and Christians devoted to fighting the secular institutions that foster anti-religious bigotry, harm families, and jeopardize the future of America. Rabbi Lapin is recognized as a national leading spokesperson for ethics in business. He discussed wealth generation and profitable business and corporate giving. He is discouraged by the statement "giving back to the community" as if the process of running a profitable business is somehow "taking" or "stealing" from the community. Is profit theft? Does profiting equal plundering? Rabbi Lapin told the story of his great grandfather who was a peddler. He would come into a community, buy an unwanted item from one family, buy materials to fix up the item, and then sell it to another family for less than the cost of a new product. The peddler profited from the transaction, and so did the first family, the hardware store where the materials were purchased and the second family who saved money on the purchase. Today's business is the same. Money is more like candles than cake. Money can ignite other economic activity to produce more money; it is not in limited supply like slices of a cake. The process of creating wealth does not mean that you are taking from others. To learn more about the Rabbi's thoughts and
